Eligibility: There will be 3 Fleets. Eligible classes for Fleet 1 are: J/105, J/80, J/30, J/24, PHRF A2,

PHRF B, PHRF C. Eligible classes for Fleet 2 are: J/35, PHRF A1, PHRF A0.

Eligible for Fleet 3 is: PHRF N, CBYRA Multihull A and B.

Boats with IRC ratings will sail in their PHRF fleet and will be dual scored.

IRC crew limits shall not apply.

Each boat shall be insured with valid, third-party liability insurance with a minimum

coverage of \$300,000 USD per event or the equivalent.

Rendezvous: Rendezvous at Annapolis Area Mark "X".

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Course: There will be a distance race for all Fleets. Courses for the distance race will be as

shown in the AYC Event Sailing Instructions and will be designed to provide 3-6 hours of racing. Fleets 1 & 2 will also have 2 days of drop mark racing. The drop-mark courses will

be as shown in the AYC Event Sailing Instructions.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

2013-2016 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "If there is a conflict

between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply." A post-race penalty may be taken before the beginning of a protest hearing. The penalty will be a 30% Scoring Penalty as calculated in RRS 44.3(c).

ORC Category 4 equipment and standards are required as modified by a boat's class. Boats racing in PHRF must have a valid 4P rating issued by PHRF/Chesapeake. Boats to be scored in IRC must hold a valid PHRF/Chesapeake rating and must supply a valid IRC certificate. Endorsed certificates are not required. *Event Sailing Instructions will be*

available online and at the AYC Clubhouse two weeks prior to the event.

Scoring The Low Point System in RRS Appendix A will apply, except each boat's series score

shall be the total of all of her race scores. The distance race will be weighted at 1.5 times

the drop mark races.

Protests: Due at the AYC clubhouse within 3 hours of protesting yacht's finish.

Heard at the AYC clubhouse starting 2000 on the Friday following the race.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7+ entrants. Trophies will be presented at the annual prize giving

party on 23 November 2013.

Social: Party at AYC each Saturday at 1730 for skippers and crew.
